RESOLUTION APPROVING/~~DENYING~~ FORMATION OF

A Community Services District

Designated as, Westport Community Services District

The following resolution is now offered and read:

WHEREAS, ~~xxx~~ petitions ~~for formation of a special district to be known as / Westport Community Services District~~ for formation of a special district to be known as Westport Beach Community Services District were duly filed with the Mendocino County

Local Agency Formation Commission, together with supporting documents required by the rules of said Commission on 9/12/69 & 9/15/69

and

WHEREAS, said petitions ^{have} been processed pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 6.6 of Part 1, Division 2, Title 5 of the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, at the times and in the form and manner provided by law, said Executive Officer has given notice of public hearing by this Commission upon said petitions; and

WHEREAS, said Executive Officer has reviewed said petitions and prepared ~~x~~ reports, including his recommendations thereon, said petitions and reports having been presented to and considered by this Commission; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing by this Commission was held upon the date and at the time and place specified in said Notice of Public hearing and in any subsequent hearings; and

WHEREAS, at such hearing this Commission heard and received all oral and written protests, objections and evidence which were made, presented, or filed, and all persons present were given the opportunity to hear and be heard in respect to any matter relating to said petition and report.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the formation of a special district be known as Westport Community Services District being identified in

the files of the Mendocino County Local Agency Formation Commission as
69-10 Westport Beach Community Services District
Files No. 69-11, designated as Westport Community Services District,

be and the same is hereby approved by the Mendocino
(approved/~~denied~~)

County Local Agency Formation Commission, subject to the following
conditions and terms:


1. That the properties described in Files 69-10 and 69-11 be combined and an overall metes and bounds description be submitted that will comply with the requirements of the State of California. That all of Franklin V. C. Jones property, surrounding the community of Westport be included.
2. That a five man Board of Directors be elected by the people of the proposed district.
3. That the District be empowered to carry out functions :
 - a. To supply the inhabitants of the district with water for domestic use, irrigation, sanitation, industrial use, fire protection and recreation;
 - b. The collection, treatment or disposal of sewage, waste and storm water of the district and its inhabitants;
 - d. Protection against fire ;of a Community Services District as enumerated in Government Code Section 61600.
4. That the District be designated as Westport Community Services District.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Executive Officer of
said Commission is hereby authorized and directed to mail certified copies
of this resolution in the manner as provided by law.
