2. That a five man Board of Directors be elected by the people of the proposed district.
 That the District be empowered to carry out functions: a. To supply the inhabitants of the district with water for domestic use, irrigation, sanitation, industrial use, fire protection and recreation; b. The collection, treatment or disposal of sewage, waste and storm water of the district and its inhabitants; d. Protection against fire; of a Community Services District as enumerated in Government Code Section 61600.
4. That the District be designated as Westport Community Services District.
