RESOLUTION MAKING DETERMINATIONS

ON THE PROPOSAL DESIGNATED AS:

GARZINI ANNEXATION TO CALPELLA

COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

(LAFCO FILE NO. 80-7)

WHEREAS, the district Reorganization act, in Sections 56000 et. seq. of the Government Code, does establish certain preliminary procedures which shall apply to proposals such as the Garzini Annexation

, and

WHEREAS, the Preliminary Proceedings were initiated when the Executive Officer of the Commission accepted for filing the subject application and issued a Certificate of Filing on 14 January 1981.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

The short term designation for the affected territory shall be

Garzini Annexation to the Calpella County

Water District

; and

The affected territory shall be bounded as described in the attached Legal Description; and

The affected territory is uninhabited as defined by Section 56074 of the Government Code; and

The executive Officer did set the proposal for hearing on

2 February 1981 and did give notice at the time and in the

manner prescribed by law; and

The Executive Officer did review the application filed with him and did prepare a report, including his recommendations, thereon; and

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, the Commission has conditioned approval of the proposal upon adoption of a Negative Declaration

_____ ; and

The Commission, at their meeting on 2 February 1981, held a public hearing as noticed, and heard and received all oral and written protests, objections or evidence which were made, presented, or filed, and considered the report of the Executive Officer and the plan for providing municipal services to the territory.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that:

The proposed Garzini Annexation to the Calpella County Water District

is approved with the following amendments and/or conditions:

1. Approval of Negative Declaration; and,
2. Correction of written description to the satisfaction of the County Surveyor.

The Calpella County Water District is designated as the conducting authority and is directed to initiate proceedings pursuant to the District Reorganization Act, in Sections 56290 et. seq. of the Government Code; and

The Executive Officer shall mail a certified copy of this Resolution to:

- a. The conducting authority;
- b. The chief petitioners, if any; and,
- c. Each affected city, county and district.
