

**Resolution # 2002-01**

**Local Agency Formation Commission of Mendocino County**  
*Resolution of Approval after Protest Hearing for Laytonville County Water District  
Annexation—January 01*

*Whereas on December 3, 2001 the Local Agency Formation Commission of Mendocino County held a public hearing and approved, via minute order and resolution, the application of the Laytonville County Water District to annex approximately 900 acres containing 251 parcels, ( short form titled Laytonville Water District Annexation January, 2001) and;*

*Whereas, on February 4, 2002 the Commission held a protest hearing on its decision and;*

*Whereas, the registered voters and landowners of the affected territory were noticed per the requirements of Government Code Section 57025 and;*

*Whereas, by the conclusion of the protest hearing, the Commission received protests from registered voters that were less than 25 percent of registered voters, and;*

*Whereas, by the conclusion of the protest hearing, the Commission received protests from landowners that were less than 25 percent of landowners who own 25 percent or more of assessed valuation and;*

*Whereas, the number of either registered voter protests or landowner protests did not approach the threshold values required per Government Code Section 57075 or 57078 for an election or termination;*

*Now, therefore be it resolved, determined and ordered by the Mendocino Local Agency Formation as follows:*

- (1) The annexation and sphere amendment for Laytonville County Water District as determined by their decision on December 3, 2001, is to stand and is approved.*
- (2) The Executive Officer shall prepare and record a Certificate of Completion upon receipt of the final map and legal description from the Laytonville County Water District.*
