RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION
COMMISSION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND APPROVING THE

Stanley Annexation to the City of Fort Bragg

WHEREAS, a proposal for the proposed Stanley
annexation to the City of Fort Bragg
has been filed with the Executive Officer of this Local Agency
Formation Commission pursuant to Title 5, Division 3, commencing
with Section 56000 of the Government Code; and,

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer has reviewed the proposal and
prepared a report having been presented to, and considered by
this Commission; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined to the satisfaction of this
Commission that all owners of land included in the proposal
consent to this annexation; and,

WHEREAS, this Commission called for and held a public
hearing on the proposal on February 4, 1991 and at the
hearing this Commission heard and received all oral and written
protests, objections and evidence which were made, presented or
filed, and all persons present were given an opportunity to hear
and be heard with respect to this proposal and the report of the
Executive Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mendocino County Local Agency Formation
Commission DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

1. The proposal, being identified in the files of the

CONDITIONS

STANLEY ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF FORT BRAGG

1. Accept the Negative Declaration as adopted by the City of Fort Bragg.
2. Approve this annexation and designate the City of Fort Bragg as the Conducting Authority to proceed with the public hearing processing pursuant to Government Code Section 57000, et seq.
3. A General Plan Amendment and re-zoning designation must be approved following action by the Conducting Authority.
4. The State Board of Equalization is to establish a new code area within the City limits as directed by the County Auditor and LAFCO to apply tax revenues to Fort Bragg Rural Fire District.

2. The boundaries, as set forth in the proposal, are hereby approved.

3. The territory includes 8.7045 acres, and is found to be uninhabited/~~unimproved~~, and is assigned the distinctive short form designation: Stanley Annexation to the City of Fort Bragg, File #90-4.

4. The City of Fort Bragg is designated as the conducting authority and is hereby authorized to conduct subsequent proceedings in compliance with this resolution.

5. The Executive Officer is hereby authorized and directed to mail certified copies of this resolution as provided in Section 56853 of the Government Code.
